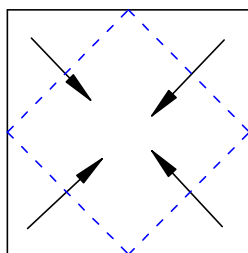


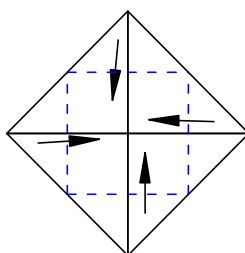
Extended Bird Base by Joshua Koppel

This is a very versatile base. I have used it to create a large number of models.

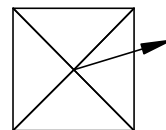
Begin with a square sheet of paper with the white side up for a colored model.



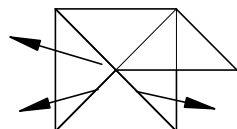
1. Fold all four corners to the center



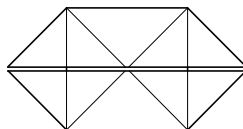
2. Fold all four corners to the center again.



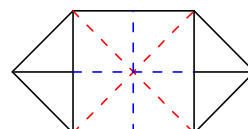
3. Pull out one of the hidden corners.



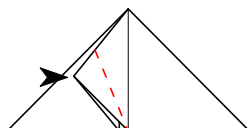
4. Pull out the other three corners.



5. Turn over.



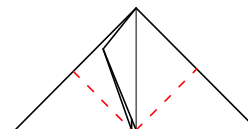
6. Form a preliminary fold in the center.



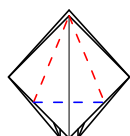
7. Sink point.



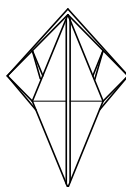
8. Repeat step 7 on other three sides.



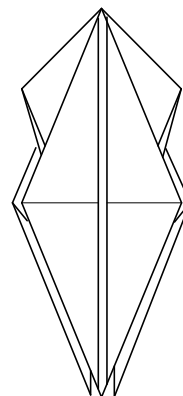
9. Squash all four corners up



10. Petal fold the front flap.



11. Petal fold the other three sides.



12. The completed Extended Bird Base.
