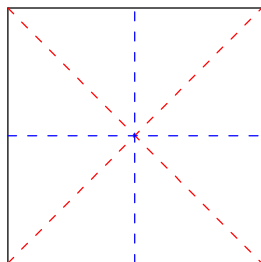
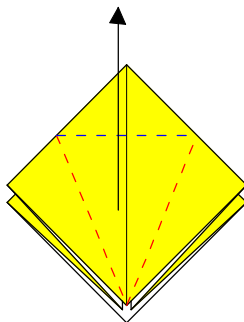


# Dragon Hatchling by Joshua Koppel

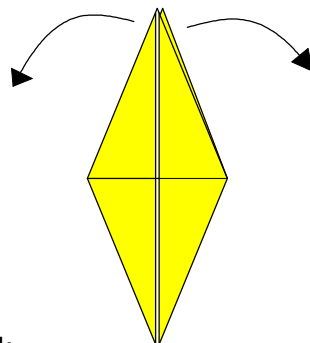
Begin with a small square of paper. If the paper is not the same color on both sides, begin with the desired color face down.



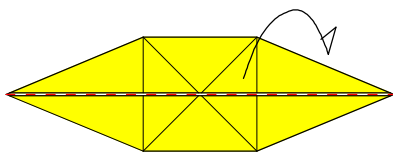
1. Fold a Preliminary Base.



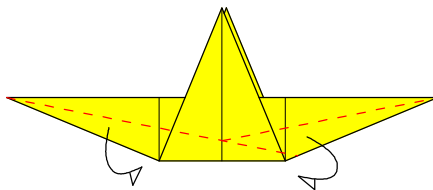
2. Petal-fold front and back.



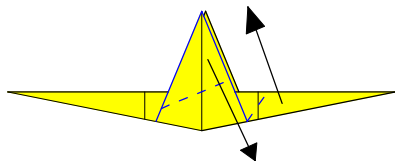
3. Pull top points apart and stretch the bird base.



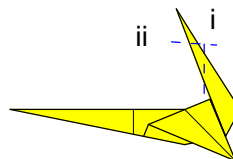
4. Mountain-fold in half lengthwise and flatten center points.



5. Thin the points with mountain-folds.

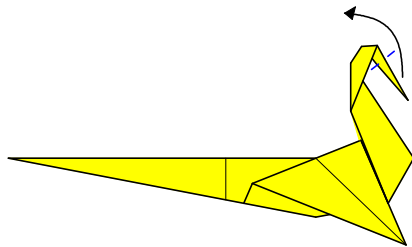


6. Valley-fold the wings down on both sides. Outside-Reverse the neck.

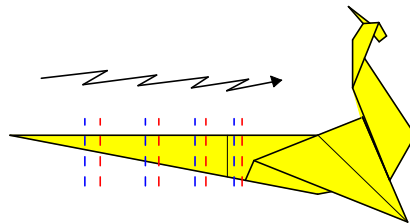


6. Outside-reverse step i. Inside-reverse step ii.

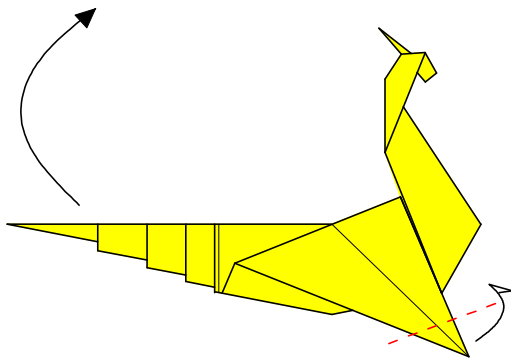

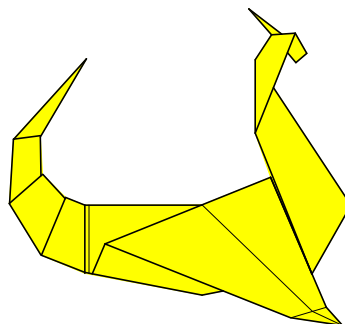
7. Inside-reverse the head.

9. Fold tips of wings inward and curl tail up.
